Polytunnels/Greenhouses on The Holding, and how they help The Farm.

e.g.: They have three big polytunnels for tomato and other warm weather crops, they also have a small greenhouse, with a stone floor, where they germinate and pot on seedlings.

"Under Glass" construction and ecological adaptions ;-

e.g.: The second hand Polytunnel had half-doors that could keep rabbits out, on the ground, but let The Air in, with The Top Half. They used bubble plastic, over the seed greenhouse to keep frost out and heat in, during The Winter and Spring.

"Under Glass" Cropping Plan on The Holding ;-

e.g.: They use the main polytunnels for warm weather plants in The Summer and for lettuce and salad crops over Winter. In the Seed Greenhouse they also use a heated seed bed, for starting the seeds in late Winter & Spring, then for cuttings and overwintering fig trees, in the Autumn and winter.

"Under Glass" environment impact;-

e.g.: The Polytunnel was second hand and so had saved energy and resources. The Conservatory was made from ecologically sourced wood and also heated The Home.

"Under Glass" pest/disease control;-

e.g.: The Polytunnel stays warm, allowing greenfly to survive The Winter. They buy in Ladybird Lava to keep the greenfly under control. The use bird netting on the doors.
